FIBRE OPTIC NETWORK

The Mandalay community will be connected through an advanced fibre optic network. This infrastructure is designed to deliver increasing functionality and capacity over time. Our fibre-optic communication network will provide a range of services such as:

- High-speed broadband internet access. This means Mandalay residents can surf the internet, download movies and music, play online games and much more, all at top speed.
- Access to Mandalay community intranet, providing information on community events, facilities and booking services as well as forums and message boards.
- Access to Foxtel Pay TV, giving you numerous package options and dozens of world-class channels for news, sports, movies and more.
- A fibre-optic enabled community allows you to connect to the network that runs past your property here at Mandalay. A fibre-optic lead-in cable connects to a device located on the side of your house.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. I have just purchased a block of land (or a house/land package) at Mandalay. What should I do next?

A. As an end-user, once you have made your purchase you should contact OptiComm on 1300 137 800 to get your information pack, and to discuss options on how you can get connected and have your home smart wired.

Q. What is smart wiring, and do I need it?

A. 'Smart wiring' is a term commonly used to describe a structured wiring system installed into a home, including the wiring of telephone, data and television points to multiple rooms. It could also be for home security, audio/video distribution, home automation and paging or intercom systems.

While it isn't mandatory to have your home smart wired, it does provide you with much greater flexibility and helps you take full advantage of your fibre-connected home. It doesn't cost very much, and can actually add value to your home.

Q. Do I require a router or modem?

A. The port on the Optical Network Terminal into which an end-user plugs their equipment is a standard Ethernet 10/100BaseT interface, and users can simply plug their personal computers directly into this interface. To take advantage of wireless technologies service providers can supply routers.
