
MANDALAY JUMPS AT PONY CLUB SPONSORSHIP

The Shire of Mitchell's landmark master-planned development 'Mandalay at Beveridge' has saddled-up for the long term benefit of the local region announcing its recent sponsorship with the Beveridge and District Pony Club.

Dedicated to supporting all facets of the local Beveridge community, Mandalay has established the Mandalay art award with the Beveridge Primary School as well as finalising further support with various sporting and social clubs in the local and surrounding regions.
